In addition, there will also be two more watercolor shows presented in The Loo Gallery and The Salon Gallery adjacent to the main gallery.

The Fallbrook Art Center is a division of the nonprofit Fallbrook Center for the Arts Group dedicated to the presentation of visual arts of all levels and types. Housed in the former Harrison Drug Rexall Pharmacy, since its opening in 1996, FAC has continued to expand its offerings gathering attention in the region and across the Western U.S. for such presentations as *Reflections of Nature*, our annual wildlife art show, *Galaxy of Glass*, and *Wheels of Desire*, a show featuring motorcycles and related art. In 2009, Fallbrook was named as one of the 'Best Art Towns in California'. The majority of shows are curated by the Center's Executive Director, Mary Perhacs, who has been with the organization since 1998.
